

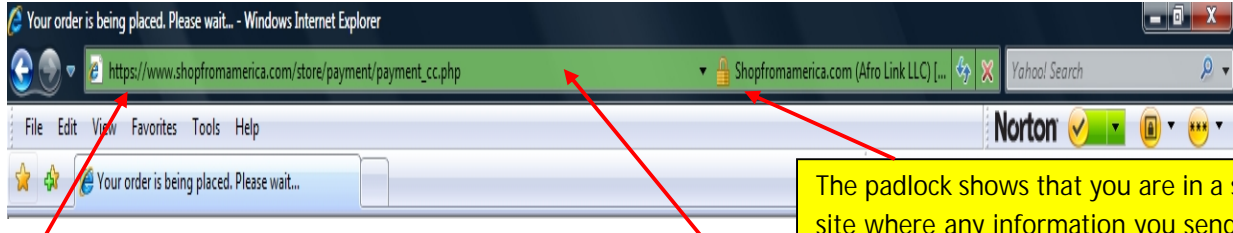
Debit cards such as those issued by InterSwitch are among the quickest ways to withdraw cash at an ATM as well as to quickly and safely make online purchases. In a town like Lagos using them to make online purchases on ShopFromAmerica.com can save you hours in traffic jam and guarantee purchase of quality products. Cases of fraud are just due to lack of understanding of its proper use by Nigerians as this phenomenon is relatively new. To guard against this, ShopFromAmerica Nigeria Limited has put together these few and vital points.

- 1) Never answer emails that seem to come from your Bank or InterSwitch asking you to update your account information. Your account details (card number, expiry date, pin or account passwords) can be stolen by this process called phishing. Banks, InterSwitch and ShopFromAmerica.com will never ask for your account information by phone or email. No matter how genuine it looks, don't reply or answer the email. Some of the emails/website will threaten to suspend your account if you don't follow their advice. Just ignore these as they are just designed to make you take the wrong step. Also be ware of bogus text messages or websites that ask you to re-enter your account information. If for any reason your card is not working, call the customer service number on the card or walk into your nearest bank to complain. Never call a number you get from an email or a website you received from an email. Don't click on link on these emails as they may contain malicious software that can steal your information. Just delete.
- 2) Don't make online purchases on computers in Internet Cafes as most have out of date antivirus. Some people may have also installed programs that can steal your personal information while using them.
- 3) Before making an online purchase, be sure the website uses a secured payment page. Secured sites such as ShopFromAmerica.com use Secure Socket Layer (SSL) to ensure your data is safe and can not be stolen. ShopFromAmerica.com even took security a step further by implementing Extended Validation (EV) SSL. This is visible by the signs on the next page, and all sites should have this before you make purchases online. The next page shows what is expected from any site and specifically ShopFromAmerica.com showing the implemented security features to ensure safe shopping. - 4) Don't let anyone, not even your brothers or sisters know your pin, card expiry dates or account passwords. There is really no reason for someone else to know your pin except they want to make withdrawals from your account.

- 1) Delete any email that says it's from InterSwitch or your Bank asking you to update your account information. Don't even reply it, just delete it and call your bank.
- 2) Don't update your account details on any site that looks like your Bank, InterSwitch or even ShopFromAmerica.com
- 3) Make sure your anti-virus software is up to date. We recommend Norton Internet Security that you can purchase by clicking this link. We are offering free shipping on Norton Internet Security softwares to Nigeria. Use coupon code securenig at checkout.
- 4) If you have issues with your card, only call numbers on the card or given to you by your bank, or walk into your bank and inquire. Don't call number you get from emails or bogus websites.
- 5) Only shop on sites you trust and we recommended making online purchases only on ShopFromAmerica.com based on its highly advanced security features.
- 6) You and ONLY you should know your pin, card expiry date and online bank account passwords.
